Iâ€™m writing on behalf of the Energy Equipment and Infrastructure Alliance (EEIA) in support of the Appalachian Reliability Project, FERC Docket CP25-528-000. EEIA represents the energy infrastructure construction supply chain: hundreds of companies and thousands of workers supplying construction, equipment, materials and services to energy infrastructure projects.

Additional natural gas infrastructure is critically needed to fuel fast-growing demand for electricity to power manufacturing, homes and businesses, computing capacity, and general electrification.
