
The Board of Supervisors of Franklin Township, Greene County, Pennsylvania takes great pride in watching our region prosper and grow. We have watched Pennsylvania, Ohio and West Virginia experience tremendous economic activity because of Marcellus and Utica Shale activity.

This upswing in local opportunity is greatly influenced by the influx of business growth resulting from energy infrastructure development in our region. Companies like Eastern Gas Transmission & Storage, Inc. (EGTS), which constructs and operates interstate natural gas facilities, and has a significant presence in Western Pennsylvania, Eastern Ohio and West Virginia, are literally fueling the local and United States economy.

Through the proposed Appalachian Reliability Project (ARP), EGTS will meet the growing energy needs of customers across the region.
