The Board of County Commissioners, Monroe County, OH express our strong support for Eastern Gas Transmission and Storage's (EGTS) Appalachian Reliability Project, which will include Monroe County's Mullett Compressor Station in Switzerland Township, German Ridge Road. An 11,100 hp turbine unit will be installed with an upgrade to the existing unit.

Eastern Gas Transmission and Storage safely operates nearly 4,000 miles of pipeline and more than 985,000 horsepower of compression, offering one of the largest underground natural gas storage systems in the United States. The proposed Appalachian Reliability Project (ARP) will meet the growing energy needs of customers across the region. ARP will leverage existing EGTS infrastructure while increasing the capacity on its system through pipeline additions and station upgrades. This will create 550,000 dekatherms/day of incremental firm transportation capacity from a new receipt point in Armstrong County, PA for delivers to Texas Eastern Pipeline in Westmoreland County, PA and the Rockies Express Pipeline (REX) in Monroe County, OH.
